At Vivere Music, we believe child safety is a shared responsibility. All staff, teachers, and volunteers play a vital role in upholding a safe learning space and are expected to speak up if concerns arise. We will regularly review our practices and welcome feedback from families, students, and our team to strengthen our commitment to child safety and wellbeing.
